To Get to the Walk Location:

Mt. Vernon Square is directly across from the Walter E. Convention Center. The Mt. Vernon Sq. 7th St. Convention Ctr. Metrorail Station (SW corner of 7th and M Streets NW) is accessible via the Yellow and Green lines. Street parking is accessible on K Street, and there are many nearby surface lots and parking garages – the closest are the parking garage at the Renaissance Hotel across the street and the surface lot at City Center on 9th and New York Avenue.
